## TOPIC: Combination locks, out of service equipment and repairs

## Who can change the combination of a dial-type lock?

Only persons authorized access to the level of information protected within can change the combinations to dial-type locks.

When should combinations be changed?
There are three conditions under which combinations will be changed.
1 - When the lock is placed in use.
2 - When a person who knows the combinations no longer requires access.
3 - When a combination has been subject to a possible unauthorized disclosure.
What steps must be taken when security equipment is placed out of service?
1 - It shall be inspected to ensure that no classified information remains
2-The combination lock should be reset to a standard combination of 50-25-50 for built-in combination locks or $10-20-30$ for combination padlocks.

## When can key operated locks be used?

Under special circumstances, an agency head may approve the use of key operated locks for the storage of Secret and Confidential information.

## What about repairs?

The neutralization and repair of GSA-approved security containers and vault doors will be in accordance with FED STD 809.
