This responds to your request for assistance from the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS), received on December 23, 2014. Your request for assistance pertains to your records request ([REDACTED]) to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for records related to [REDACTED].

Congress created OGIS to complement existing Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) practice and procedure; we strive to work in conjunction with the existing request and appeal process. The goal is for OGIS to allow, whenever practical, the requester to exhaust his or her remedies within the agency, including the appeal process. OGIS has no investigatory or enforcement power, nor can we compel an agency to release documents. OGIS serves as the Federal FOIA Ombudsman and our jurisdiction is limited to assisting with the FOIA process.

We carefully reviewed your submission of information, and contacted the FBI FOIA Public Liaison Dennis Argall to inquire about the status of your request. Mr. Argall advised us that the FBI replied to your message on December 15, 2014 (see attached), informing you that the agency accessioned (sent) any potentially responsive material related to [REDACTED] to the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). He further provided a file number that we have highlighted for you ready reference. Mr. Argall advised that you should submit a FOIA request to NARA for these records. You may do so by contacting:
