The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) has been notified of a potential unauthorized disposition of records at the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). A former employee of the agency alleges that in 2005 and 2006, the New Orleans VA Medical Center improperly altered SF-50 Notification of Personnel Action records and failed to properly document his retirement status.

NARA requests that the VA investigate this matter and provide NARA with a response within 30 days in accordance with 36 CFR 1230.16. Your report should include a description of the records; details regarding the records incident and recovery efforts; and a statement of the safeguards that have been or will be implemented to prevent unauthorized dispositions in the future.
