Dear Cecilia Wiker,

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) acknowledges receipt of the Defense Logistics Agency's (DLA) report regarding the loss of over 445 million records relating to Procurement, Tech Quality, and Real Property management.

According to the report and subsequent email conversations with NARA staff, the records were accidentally deleted due to improperly configured records retention rules. The majority of the records were routine financial documents with retention periods of less than 10 years. We understand that efforts were made to retrieve or reconstruct the records but were unsuccessful. We further understand that to prevent future loss of records DLA is developing procedures to confirm that valid backups and/or replication of data are being taken for all production databases and file systems. DLA is also reviewing its change management processes to ensure that DLA leadership is notified and approves of any changes to infrastructure or systems.
